RESOLUTION NO. 03-2020 This resolution calls upon Temple Student Government executive branch to follow up and hold Facilities and Operations accountable for placing sanitary bins in all female restrooms on campus.

CURRENTLY, Facilities and Operations has been contacted and has placed an order for 100 sanitary bins for placement in all female restrooms which currently lack them.

KNOWING, that lack of sanitary bins can cause clogged plumbing, septic issues, student and staff exposure to a biohazard, improper storage of waste, and inconvenience to the individual.

UNDERSTANDING, Temple Student Government has the responsibility to advocate for all students, thus including advocating for uniform access to proper sanitary waste disposal.

OPERATIVE- CLAUSE, Temple Student Government Executive Branch should conduct a check of main campus female restrooms one (1) time per year in the fall semester in order to ensure all bathrooms contain sanitary bins.

OPERATIVE- CLAUSE, Biology Life Science and Pearson Hall have not been checked, therefore they must be checked before the end of this semester, Fall 2019.
