

Executive Directive 05-2021 April 26, 2021

DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF STUDENT AFFAIRS, DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF LOCAL AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, AND ALL OTHER PERTINENT TEMPLE STUDENT GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL TO CREATE A COHESIVE AND REFORMATIVE PACKAGE OF RECOMMENDATIONS TO BE PRESENTED TO THE OFFICE OF NEW STUDENT AND FAMILY PROGRAMS

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution of the Temple Student Government, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. *Purpose*.

- (a) Temple Student Government shall suggest changes to the University's New Student Orientation program in order to improve aspects of the presentation of TSG familiarity, North Philadelphia history and culture, accessibility, sexual violence, etc.
- (b) As to improve upon the Office of New Student and Family's current New Student Orientation program, which does not include a historical component pertaining to the surrounding North Philadelphia community.
- (c) As to build upon the Office of New Student and Family Program's current New Student Orientation by including more outreach from Temple Student Government in order to increase visibility and legitimacy of the student body's government.

Section 2. Policy.

(a) The Director of Student Affairs, along with the Deputy Director of Local and Community Affairs, shall work in conjunction with the Office of New Student and Family Programs to suggest appropriate changes to New Student Orientation programs. Suggestions should be made available to the pertinent TSG and Office of New Student and Family Programs personnel.

- (b) Pertinent TSG personnel shall begin drafting a cohesive package, detailing changes to the Office of New Student and Family Programs in regards to TSG promotion and a local historical component to New Student Orientation programs.
- (c) Pertinent TSG personnel shall work in cooperation with the Office of New Student and Family Programs, once the reforms have been submitted, in order to successfully communicate and implement the changes to pertinent members of the Office of New Student and Family Programs.
