ALLOCATIONS REPORT:

TSG Financial Statistics:

Out of 713 total requests:

- 242 denied • 260 approved
- 14 unapproved 65 completed
- 131 cancelled

On average 60% were approved and 40% were denied.

**They were unapproved due to a variety of reasons like requests were submitted later than 15 business days before their event, or they needed reimbursements.
